<u>Old Business:</u> We are still waiting on the 2012 statements from the treasurer to be completed and we will then continue with the 2013-2014 ones. A direct deposit was made recently containing \$61,000 from FEMA as was a check in the amount of \$69,000 for the weed job.

<u>New Business:</u> A voucher from June Maniacek was submitted in December and a resolution will be made to move funds to cover it from 2014.

A letter of a pending lawsuit has recently been issued to cover a loss to a property owner on Steinmetz Road. According to the letter, on file in the Town Clerk's office, a claim was made about damage being done but the Town feels the damage was done on town property, not the homeowners. In question is a barrier placed without approval from the town and the plow truck striking the barrier. The homeowner put a claim in to his insurance company and a letter was sent to the town that they were trying to recoup the loss from our insurance company. A letter will be drafted stating the barriers were incorrectly and illegally erected on town property and that there will be no reimbursement for the loss from our insurance company. Sup. Gang will talk to the agent to see what other course of action we can do about this matter. Highway superintendent Hobus was not able to attend the meeting tonight as he was out plowing during a snow event but Sup. Gang reported that the new truck is parked at the town garage. It hasn't been registered yet because there are a few things that need to be addressed and corrected but they are an easy fix so it won't be a big deal.

Coun. Wilbur brought up about changing the Supervisor's term from 2 years to 4 years. Sup. Gang will look into what it will take to change that with the town attorney.

After looking further into the BAN for the new truck it seems that Community Bank does a 2 year BAN, however, after the two years the final payment will need to be made at that time. There is a 1 year BAN available and is renewable on a yearly basis and the interest rate for the 1 year is 2.49%.
