

June 8, 2020 the regular Town Board meeting was held by Zoom beginning at 7:00 p.m. and all members were in attendance except Coun. Raymond and Highway Superintendent Hobus. The pledge to the flag was led by Sup. Ferguson. A motion to accept the previous month's minutes was made by Coun. Wilbur and was seconded by Coun. Barber and all were in favor. A motion to pay the audited bills was made by Coun. Greenough and was seconded by Coun. Wilbur and all were in favor. A motion was made by Coun. Greenough and seconded by Coun. Wilbur to hold all public comments for this meeting to allow enough time to discuss town business and all were in favor.

**Old Business:** None

**New Business:** The County has been upgraded to Phase II on reopening from the State of Emergency pause. There are no new cases of Covid-19 in the county. The County Departments are still not open to the public and they are beginning to open slowly. The Motor Vehicles Department will be opening to appointments only. The Financials were updated until May and given to the board and are on file in the Clerk's office. Sup. Ferguson is continuing to work on the 2017 AUD's. A company called Hudson Wireless will be contacting the folks that signed the petition to get Spectrum in the town to discuss using white space for internet and mapping the addresses to see if a signal can be received.

James Brown will be coming up with an idea to cover the Veteran's Wall with something to prevent the continuing damage that keeps occurring to the list of names. Also, the cover will enable new names to be added and not a permanent fixture.

The 2020 Operational and Maintenance bills for Sewer District One and Fredrick's Point will be mailed out once Sup. Ferguson can get the addresses from Real Property Tax Service.

**County Business:** The town-wide Reval has begun. The Company conducting the on-site viewing will be in clearly marked vehicles and will be notifying homeowners. A new Budget Officer was appointed at the County, and his name is Brian Campbell. The two county beaches are set to open by June 15 for weekends only and are waiting for the water test results to come back.

There were no further discussions and the meeting was adjourned at 7:08 p.m.
