New Business: Resolution #6-2026 titled “**Resolution Introducing Proposed Local Law Providing For Flood Damage Prevention in the Town of Dresden**” and setting the Public Hearing on such was put forth by Coun. Resolution #7-2026 titled “**Resolution Introducing a Proposed Local Law Imposing A Moratorium on Locating Battery Energy Storage Systems and Data Centers in the Town of Dresden**” and setting the Public Hearing of such was put forth by Coun. Borden and seconded by Coun. Shad. The Public Hearing will be held on August 10, 2026, immediately following the Public Hearing for Flood Damage Prevention. The Roll Call Vote is as follows: Coun.
