Sewer District #1 Engineering Study

- 1. Preliminary Engineering Report (PER) A wrap-up Zoom meeting with the engineering team will be held on Wednesday.
 - a. **SHS to pick up invoices from Paul Ferguson calculate cost of winterization of system (October/Dec-April? Weather dependent, Superintendent makes call each year)
- 2. Invoices, Receipts Paul has final accounting information for this all accounts will be settled once PER is finalized
- 3. Next steps suggestions to possibly add meters to other parts of the system, though rates can be extrapolated from gallons per hour on the pump runtimes on parts of the system

Sewer District #1 Sewer Line Burial Project

- 1. At the last Town Hall meeting, a resolution was passed to set a meeting date for a hearing to be held for taking out financing on the project the hearing will be 3/25 at 7pm, at the Town Hall
 - a. **SHS to double check call-in number capacity and #s to send to Town Clerk MW & Town Attorney MF to add to newspaper notice of public hearing so public can call in
 - b. **PK to ensure LaBella is aware of hearing if they want to attend
- 2. Operation and Maintenance costs must be transparent
 - a. **SHS to get invoices from PF and work on historicals
 - b. There IS a ceiling amount that the sewer taxes can reach we do NOT want to approach that
 - c. **SHS to call Doran to ask them to add work location to invoices
 - i. Superintendent Bill Borden has a binder of what happened where and when in the system, also George LaPlante company has a history by serial #
