

July 13, 2020 the regular town board meeting was held in the town hall beginning at 7:00 p.m. with Coun. Wilbur and Coun. Raymond absent, as well as Highway Superintendent Hobus. Sup. Ferguson led the pledge to the flag. A motion to accept the previous month's minutes was made by Coun. Grenough and was seconded by Coun. Barber and all were in favor. A motion to pay the audited bills was made by Coun. Barber and was seconded by Coun. Greenough and all were in favor.

**Old Business:** Hudson Wireless had a discussion with Sup. Ferguson about federal monies available for coverage in the area. They are currently working in the Whitehall and Ticonderoga areas. It appears that the Dresden area will be auctioned off at the federal level to any company willing to come in and develop cell/internet coverage. It looks like it will be November before anything will be in the works. Jim Brown is still trying to come up with an idea to create a cover for the veteran's sign so there hasn't been any new progress with the project.

**New Business:** The financials were handed to the board and are on file in the Town Clerk's office. Work is continuing on the 2017 AUD.

**Resolution #10-2020** titled **Budget Transfer-General** was made by a motion from Coun. Barber and was seconded by Coun. Greenough and all were in favor.

**Resolution #11-2020** titled **Settlement Tall VS. Town of Dresden** had been tabled due to missing Councilmen for further discussion. It will be brought back to the next meeting. VTDEC has made an arrangement with the town to provide them a parking space for the upcoming weed eradication program and they have begun this season. A discussion was brought up about providing the Town Court with an air conditioner so that they may conduct court comfortably and that the District Attorney will remain comfortable while dressed in a suit during cases being heard. The board members in attendance agreed that one should be provided.

**County Business:** GAR is conducting their field study for the Re-Val and their vehicles are in the area. Sup. Ferguson posted on social media the makes, models, and license numbers of the vehicles they are using. The Washington County Beach is now open 7 days a week until Labor Day and the hours are 11 a.m. until 7 p.m.

**Highway Superintendent's Report:** Mr. Hobus was absent from this evening's meeting but Sup. Ferguson reported that the weed eradication program will begin soon.

The board wished the Town Clerk a Happy Birthday.
