A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$200,000.00 BONDS OF THE TOWN OF DRESDEN, WASHINGTON COUNTY, NEW YORK, TO PAY PART OF THE COST OF THE INCREASE AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE FACILITIES OF HULETT'S LANDING SEWER DISTRICT #1 IN THE TOWN OF DRESDEN, WASHINGTON COUNTY, NEW YORK.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Dresden, Washington County, New York, on March 25, 2024, has under consideration of a capital project to increase and improve the facilities of the Hulett's Landing Sewer District #1 in said Town (the "District"), consisting of reconstruction and relocation of a force sewer mains currently over Foster Brook including original furnishings, equipment, machinery, apparatus, appurtenances and incidental improvements and expenses, in the aggregate amount of \$200,000; and

WHEREAS, said capital project has been determined to be an Unlisted Action, with a Negative Declaration pursuant to the regulations of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation promulgated pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), the implementation of which as proposed, as such it is determined will not result in any significant environmental adverse effect; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the maximum estimated cost of said specific object or purpose is \$200,000.00; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to authorize the issuance of \$200,000.00 bonds of said Town for such specific object or purpose to pay a portion of the cost thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, by the affirmative vote of not less than two-thirds of the total voting strength of the Town Board of the Town of Dresden, Washington County, New York, as follows BE IT:

RESOLVED, the capital project hereinafter described, as proposed, has been determined to be an Unlisted Action pursuant to the regulations of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation promulgated pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act, which, it has been determined after review of the environmental assessment form and taking a hard look at the potential impacts, the implementation of such capital project, as proposed, will not result in a significant environmental effect; and be it further

RESOLVED, pursuant to the provisions heretofore duly had and taken in accordance with the provisions of Section 202-b of the Town Law, and more particularly an Order dated the date hereof, said Town Board has determined it to be in the public interest to improve the facilities of District in the Town of Dresden, Washington County, New York, at a maximum estimated cost of \$200,000.00; and be it further

RESOLVED, by the Town Board of the Town of Dresden, Washington County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. The increase and improvement of the Hulett's Landing Sewer District #1, in the Town of Dresden, Washington County, New York, consisting of reconstruction and relocation of a force sewer mains currently over Foster Brook including original furnishings, equipment, machinery, apparatus, appurtenances and incidental improvements and expenses in connection therewith, is hereby authorized at a maximum estimated cost of \$200,000.00, said cost to be allocated amongst said District as described in the Public Interest Order of even date herewith.

Section 2. It is hereby determined that the plan for the financing of such specific object or purpose is by the issuance of \$200,000.00 serial bonds hereby authorized to be issued therefor pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law; provided, however that the amount

of serial bonds to be issued therefor shall be reduced dollar for dollar by any grant monies received therefor, if any.

Section 3. It is hereby determined that the period of probable usefulness of the aforesaid specific object or purpose is thirty years pursuant to subdivision 4 of paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law, calculated from the date of the first bond anticipation note issued therefor. It is hereby further determined that the maximum maturity of the serial bonds herein authorized will exceed five years.

Section 4. Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the serial bonds herein authorized, including renewals of such notes, is hereby delegated to the Supervisor, the chief fiscal officer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said Supervisor, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 5. The faith and credit of said Town of Dresden, Washington County, New York, are hereby irrevocably pledged to the payment of the principal of and interest on such obligations as the same respectively become due and payable. An annual appropriation shall be made in each year sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations becoming due and payable in such year. To the extent not paid from monies raised from said Hulett's Landing Sewer District #1 by assessments upon the properties therein benefitted thereby and as otherwise provided by law, there shall annually be levied on all the taxable real property of said Town, a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due and payable.

Section 6. Such bonds shall be in fully registered form and shall be signed in the name of the Town of Dresden, Washington County, New York, by the manual or facsimile signature of the Supervisor and a facsimile of its corporate seal shall be imprinted or impressed thereon and may be attested by the manual or facsimile signature of the Town Clerk.

Section 7. The powers and duties of advertising such bonds for sale, conducting the sale and awarding the bonds, or the private sale or issuance of such bonds, are hereby delegated to the Supervisor, who shall advertise such bonds for sale, conduct the sale, award the bonds, or otherwise sell the bonds, in such manner as he shall deem best for the interests of said Town; provided, however, that in the exercise of these delegated powers, the Supervisor shall comply fully with the provisions of the Local Finance Law and any order or rule of the State Comptroller applicable to the sale of municipal bonds. The receipt of the Town shall be a full acquittance to the purchaser of such bonds, who shall not be obliged to see to the application of the purchase money.

Section 8. All other matters, except as provided herein relating to such bonds, including determining whether to issue such bonds having substantially level or declining debt service and all matters related thereto, prescribing whether manual or facsimile signatures shall appear on said bonds, prescribing the method for the recording of ownership of said bonds, appointing the fiscal agent or agents for said bonds, providing for the printing and delivery of said bonds (and if said bonds are to be executed in the name of the Town by the facsimile signature of its Supervisor, providing for the manual countersignature of a fiscal agent or of a designated official of the Town), the date, denominations, maturities and interest payment dates, place or places of payment, and also including the consolidation with other issues, shall be determined by the Supervisor.

- Section 9. The validity of such bonds and bond anticipation notes may be contested only if:
 - Such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which said Town is not authorized to expend money, or
 - 2) The provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of publication of this resolution are not substantially complied with,

and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or

3) Such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

Section 10. This resolution shall constitute a statement of official intent for purposes of Treasury Regulations Section 1.150-2. Other than as specified in this resolution, no monies are, or are reasonably expected to be, reserved, allocated on a long-term basis, or otherwise set aside with respect to the permanent funding of the object or purpose described herein.
